- Directs up to six operators on production line for assigned shift
- Lead three production lines ensuring quality checks and production needs are met
- Must maintain minimum daily quota for each line
- Ensure that assigned team members are compliant with company safety, quality and operational policies
- Coach / mentor and train staff providing feedback to operators in appropriate and effective manner
- Ensure that team members strive to exceed manufacturing goals
- Apply strategic / proactive applications to assure efficient execution of plans.
- Control, maintain, and distribute production reporting information.
- Structure and prioritize personnel assignments and training
- Provide cross over to ensure proper flow of information up-line and between shifts.
- Complete all necessary paperwork and transactions including shift reports, backflushing, and all other reporting as needed
- Abide by all work instructions and suggest modifications as necessary
- Troubleshoot mechanical issues at the line and participate as needed in any repairs
- Start-up and shut down of equipment
